

StudentCrowd Review Guidelines

Guidelines for Students

1. **Be respectful of other people:** No profanities, vulgarities, harassing language, personal attacks, belittling, threats of violence or discriminatory language.
2. **Only include true and accurate information:** The content of your review has to be 100% honest.
3. **Only include your own experience and opinion:** Ensure your review includes only your own content, keep it original.
4. **Relevant:** The information in the review has to be directly relevant to the topic you are reviewing.
5. **Swear filter:** We have a 'swear filter' on the site that censors words considered to be inappropriate.

Reviews will be removed in the following instances

1. **The promotion of illegal activities:** Content that encourages or supports behaviour that is illegal. This includes; violence, fraud, illegal drug use, underage drinking, or child or animal abuse. No content produced by or on behalf of terrorist groups. The laws of England and Wales are our guideline for determining illegality, although laws from other countries will be considered if appropriate to the context of the relevant post.
2. **Misconduct:** Content containing information on misconduct is generally **allowed** even if it mentions illegal activity.
3. **Discriminatory or offensive views:** Content that promotes intolerance for individuals or groups of people based on their race, gender, religion, sexual preference, or nationality.
4. **Sexually explicit content:** Content that is obscene, pornographic, or lewd, or that contains nudity or sexually explicit images.
5. **Confidential information:** Content containing confidential information or personal information related to other people.
6. **Names:** We allow names in both negative or positive comments but if the review is even slightly in conflict with another review guideline, then it will be removed. If someone requests a review to be removed due to their name being included we will always honour this.
7. **Promotional activity:** Advertising of businesses or services. No spamming; chain letters, junk mail, 'spam', business, promoting blogs or bulk communications of any kind.
8. **Fraudulent reviews:** This includes; writing a review for your own company, impersonating a reviewer for another company, writing a review on the behalf of anyone, asking people to submit reviews in exchange for something.
9. **Cheating:** Content which would enable anyone to gain an unfair advantage over others in interviews, academic work or similar.
10. **Technically harmful content:** This includes; computer viruses, logic bombs, Trojan horses, worms, harmful components, corrupted data or other malicious software or harmful data.
